Scene 2: What is Medicare?

Federal health program

Medicare is a federal health insurance program, primarily for people sixty-five and older and some younger people with disabilities or specific conditions. It's administered by CMS and enrollment for Parts A and B often goes through Social Security. It's separate from employer insurance and separate from Medicaid.

Scene 3: Parts A · B · C · D

The building blocks

Part A: hospital insurance - inpatient care, skilled nursing in some cases, hospice. Part B: medical insurance - doctor visits, outpatient care, preventive services. Part C: Medicare Advantage - an alternative way to get A and B through approved private plans, often with Part D included. Part D: prescription drug coverage through private plans. Costs and coverage details change yearly - verify on Medicare dot gov.
